



## **Master of Law Study Program Holds Field Trips and Public Lectures to Yogyakarta**

On the first day the group held a "Research Methodology Workshop" which was opened directly by Ka. Master of Law Study Program Dr. Marlina, S.H, M.H which was held at Boutique Hotel Jl. Prof. Herman Yohanes No.1, Terban, Kec. Gondokusuman, City of Yogyakarta, Special Region of Yogyakarta.
